

Launched in November 2022, the BeAusome Erasmus+ project aims to cultivate digital skills and competences of parents and teachers of children on the Autism Spectrum, and increase the children's engagement in the learning process through the integration of new interactive technologies and innovative tools in the teaching pedagogies.

The project Consortium, formed by 6 European entities (Społeczna Akademia Nauk- Coordinator- and Fundacja Zrozumiec Autyzm from Poland, Perifereiaki Diefthynsi Protovathmias kai Defterovathmias Ekpaidefsis Kentrikis Makedonias from Greece, Special School Nicosia and A & A Emphasys Interactive Solutions Ltd from Cyprus, and Associação Portuguesa para as Perturbações do Desenvolvimento e Autismo de Coimbra from Portugal), has already developed:

- The Social Competence Framework for children with ASD
- Professional Development Programme Material for Educators
- Digital assessment methodology by Open Badges

The BeAusome Educational Pack with online and offline scenarios, and the BeAusome Library with a collection of helpful materials and resources are currently under development.

Following the first Transnational Project Meeting on 9th and 10th February in Łódź, Poland, the partners participated online in the second Transnational Project Meeting on 28th September 2023. The agenda included updates on the progress of the project, specifically the BeAusome Dual pack, the development of the VR game for students, the creation of an e-learning platform with an e-community and forum for educators, and the design of webinars for parents and educators. The partners have also started planning the training mobilities of the instructors who are going to train educators and parents on how to implement the results of the project.

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
